Teams will not be allowed to compete until their documentation has been submitted, verified, and approved (tournament affidavit, boundary map, player verification forms, residency documentation, medical waivers, coaching clearances, and necessary waivers). Please see your District Administrator immediately if you are unclear of any matters related to the required documentation.

Pennsylvania District 27 and Upper Providence Little League strongly believe that all games are to be decided on the field by the players in accordance with the Little League Official Regulations and Play Rules – in particular, rule XIV(a) – Field Decorum will be strictly enforced:

The actions of players, managers, coaches, umpires, and league officials must be above reproach. Any player, manager, coach, umpire, or league official who is involved in a verbal or physical altercation, or an incident of unsportsmanlike conduct at the game site or any other Little League activity is subject to disciplinary actions by District 27 and the local league board of directors.

Unsportsmanlike conduct by players, managers, coaches, or fans from the opposing team to disrupt the play of any player, especially the pitcher, will not be tolerated and will be dealt with immediately. Managers are expected to control the behavior of their team and fans.

Special thanks to all the volunteers, umpires, District 27 Staff, Upper Providence LL board members, donors, sponsors, vendors, and EMS workers who devoted endless hours to make this tournament a success. Without all of you, none of this would be possible.

Schedule of Events

Sunday, July 26, 2026 –

Team Check-in –

Check-in for teams will be held on Sunday (7/26) from 1:00-3:00 pm at MacFarlan Park, the home of Upper Providence Little League. At this time, the manager should meet with the D27 District Admin Staff to submit and review all their required documentation. We will be meeting at the Pavilion behind the main field.

Coaches Meeting –

There will be a mandatory meeting at the pavilion at MacFarlan Park on Sunday (7/26) at 3:30 pm for all managers and coaches listed on the official affidavit. Any League Presidents and/or District Administrators travelling with the team may attend as well. The meeting will be run by the PA District 27 Staff, D27 Umpires, and UPLL League Officials. This meeting will take place at the Pavilion behind the main field.

Tournament Banquet –

Upper Providence Little League will host a pre-tournament Catered Dinner on Sunday (7/26) from approximately 5:00 to 8:00 pm. The banquet will be set up under the batting cage pavilion at MacFarlan Park. All teams are expected to attend the banquet. The dinner is free for all players and coaches. Additional information regarding tickets parents and fans will be available soon.

Practice –

If you'd like to have a practice in the morning of Sunday (7/26), please contact the Tournament Staff to arrange for a field and/or batting cage for practice. All practices will be concluded by 1:00 pm.

Monday, July 27, 2026 –

Games – Consult the game schedule for game times in the morning.

Opening Ceremony – On Monday (7/27), we will have an opening ceremony at approximately 2:45 pm where each team will be introduced and led onto the field. We will introduce the Tournament and District Staff as well as the District Umpires. Teams should be prepared to line up around 2:15-2:30 pm.

TOURNAMENT RULES

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

District 27 always promotes good sportsmanship and at all levels of play. Throughout this tournament, any conduct that is meant to demean or incite opposing teams, spectators, or officials will not be tolerated. All verbal comments must be positive and encouraging. Spectating offenders will be removed from the complex for the remainder of the tournament. Coaches or players who are ejected from a game, per LL tournament rules, will not be permitted to participate in the next scheduled game.

The facility is smoke, tobacco, and alcohol free. Any violation of this policy will result in immediate removal from the complex. **Thank you for your cooperation.**

- The PA State LL Tournament will be a double elimination tournament.
- Playing rules will be per LL Majors Baseball Tournament rules. All rules will be strictly enforced by the tournament staff and umpires.
- Pitching logs must be verified and signed immediately after each game.
- The Tournament Director and staff reserve the right to change game dates and starting times due to inclement weather.
- The team travelling furthest to the complex will occupy first base for each game. The team in the first base dugout will call the coin toss to determine home and away.
- Both teams will have sufficient warm up time on the Majors field. Times can be adjusted on an as needed basis.
- The team manager is responsible for uniforms and equipment.
- All players must be in uniform with the LL approved patch. The patch may NOT be printed on the uniform. Must be the physical patch.
- Only managers, coaches, and players listed on the official tournament eligibility affidavit are permitted in the dugout or playing field. Under no circumstance will coaching (or assistance to coaching) be permitted by anyone outside of the dugout area during games. This includes pre-game warm-ups.
- If you plan to reference a score book or GameChanger, then that scorekeeper must be one of the three coaches on the affidavit and in the dugout.
- Game balls will be provided by Upper Providence Little League and District 27.
- Both teams will line up as directed by the Tournament Director and introduced and remain there for the National Anthem and Little League Pledge.
- Both teams will meet at the home plate area immediately at the conclusion of the game and tip hats as a show of sportsmanship and respect.
- When a team is eliminated from the tournament, the eliminated team will be presented with tournament pins.
- At the conclusion of the tournament, the winning team will be awarded the PA Championship Flag, a team trophy and player medallions.
